1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

Event Title: Round 4 2008 NSW MOTOR RACE CHAMPIONSHIP MEETING
Date: Saturday 26th & Sunday 27th July 2008.
Venue: Oran Park Grand Prix Circuit Cobbitty Rd Narellan NSW 2567.

2. ORGANISATION & STATUS

2.1 The meeting will be a State Race Meeting, and will be held under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules, and the Race Meeting Standing Regulations of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd, hereinafter referred to as "CAMS", the relevant State Championship Sporting Regulations and the 2008 Production Sportscar Enduro Regulations, as approved by CAMS, these Supplementary Regulations and any other Regulations and / or Instructions that may be issued. The event shall be a NSW State Motor Race Championship meeting.

- 5.5 Insufficient Entries: Should insufficient entries be received from one or more of the categories invited, the following may apply. The entry fee for those entries may be returned, **OR**, the combining of appropriate categories, in consultation with CAMS will apply. This will be done with due consideration to the State Championships and the Categories.
- 5.6 Withdrawal of Entry: Should a Competitor be forced to withdraw his/her entry from this meeting, then the Organisers may consider a credit. To be considered for this 'credit', the withdrawal of entry is to be notified 'in writing', with reason/s for withdrawal to the Race Secretary, no later than the Monday prior to the Meeting, unless extenuating circumstances prevail. Competitors passes, unused and intact, should be forwarded to the Race Secretary no later than 5 days after the date of the meeting to complete the application for a Credit. If a credit is granted, it is only valid for the next meeting conducted by the Organiser's for the category involved.
- 5.7 Refusal of Entry: The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor in accordance with NCR 83.

6. EVENTS

Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with regulations for the following categories as outlined in the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, series regulations and Bulletins where applicable. AF2/Supersports - Clubmans-Formula Vee - Formula Ford - Production Sports Cars - Sports Sedans – Improved Production - Combined Touring - Holden HQ's and Saloon Cars. An Endurance Race format will be held for Production Sports, all other categories will have Sprint races

7. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors must hold a CAMS PCC or PC licence or higher grade licence to participate at this meeting. A valid CAMS Competition licence, CAMS-Affiliated Car Club Membership Card, and CAMS Vehicle Logbook must be presented at document check.

8. TIMING

Will be AUTOMATIC using the Dorian Data-1 system. Competitors wishing to compete at this meeting, require a Dorian transponder in working order, securely fitted to their vehicle. The control line for the purpose of timing will be the Start/Finish line.

9. CREDENTIALS

All competitors will receive 4 Competitor passes with each entry. No vehicle passes will be issued for this meeting.

10. PRACTISE/GARAGES

Private practise is available at Oran Park on the Friday 25th JULY 2008, from 9.30am – 4.30pm. Cost will be \$130, and should be paid directly to Oran Park. Competitors should contact Oran Park (Kim) on 02 4646 1004 for the hiring of garages / car ports, and for any further information.

11. SCRUTINEERING

Targeted Scrutiny will be the method of scrutiny for this event. The chief scrutineer will determine which vehicles will be audited and those competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at event documentation scrutiny. Please note; APPAREL should not be presented unless requested to do so. Drivers may be subject to an apparel check in Parc Ferme.

12. MEDICAL

Ambulance Transport Provisions: After completing a thorough Risk Assessment, the Organisers have been granted dispensation from CAMS for the requirement to have an ambulance on site at all times that can transport on public roads under emergency conditions. The ambulance being provided for this meeting is NOT authorised to transport patients on the road under lights and sirens.

All other Medical Services / Requirements as per Section 2 of the 2008 CAMS Manual are being fully met by the Organisers, and a Medical Plan has been submitted and approved by CAMS.

13. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

14. INSURANCE

For details of CAMS Insurance provisions please refer Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

15. PROTESTS

All protests must be submitted in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

16. POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

The organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.
